Norm Snyder Award

Eligibility

To be eligible for the award, a nominee must meet the following criteria:

- [1.] Be a member in good standing in accordance with the provisions of Bylaw 2, Section (1).
- [2.] Be currently serving on either:
 - (a) a District/Bargaining Unit/Branch Committee, or District/Bargaining Unit/Branch Executive;
- [3.] Be nominated by a resolution of the District/Bargaining Unit Executive;

Criteria

- [1.] The nominee shall have primarily served the members of OSSTF/FEESO as a volunteer.
- [2.] The Selection Committee will place a stronger emphasis on local versus provincial contributions.
- [3.] The nominee must have made an outstanding contribution during the 2008-2009 and/or 2009-2010 school year.

Nominations

- [1.] Nominations shall be made only on the official nomination form, with a copy of the Executive Resolution attached.
- [2.] Nominations shall be forwarded to the Provincial Office to arrive no later than **Friday, April 9, 2010**.
- [3.] Nominations should be addressed to the attention of: **Pierre Côté, Associate General Secretary**.

Selection Committee

The Selection Committee will consist of:

- [1.] The two Vice-Presidents of OSSTF/FEESO;
- [2.] Two members of the Provincial Executive to be appointed by the President;
- [3.] The Associate General Secretary, who shall chair the Committee and shall vote only in the event of a tie.

Publicity

OSSTF/FEESO will publicize the contributions of the winner of the award, and of others whom the Committee considers worthy of honourable mention in its publications.
