Embracing Technology Conference **Registration Now Being Accepted**

OSSTF/FEESO has been provided with additional funding to support a professional development conference to specifically build the capacity of OSSTF/FEESO members working directly with students. This funding is being specifically offered to support OSSTF/FEESO members working in district school boards.

This one-day conference will be held on **Monday, May 15, 2017** at the Sheraton Toronto Airport Hotel and Conference Centre. The conference theme of *Embracing Technology*, will begin with speaker Colleen Rose whose keynote address will address the fear that many of our members have about utilizing technology in their educational roles. Registration for the conference is open to those members working in publicly funded schools – front-line members working with students who are described as ‘reluctant learners’ are the target audience for this conference.

The conference will offer up to 15 workshops – all led by front-line, OSSTF/FEESO members. As no proposals for French workshops were submitted, we are unable to offer any French language workshops. A few exhibitor tables will also be on site.

Funding for this conference was provided to OSSTF/FEESO to ‘build educator capacity’ in the area of technology. The conference will be open to all teachers and support staff who are supporting the learning of students in schools. Members from Districts 1 to 33 will be invited to register; the allocation for district based conferences reflects district FTE numbers. Districts are responsible for determining which members are to register. The maximum number of registrants for the conference will be 150 members.

Due to the short timelines between now and May 15, there will be two registration deadlines – the first deadline of April 18, 2017 will process complete registrations received on a first-come, first-served basis as per the district allocations outlined below. In the event that 150 registrations as assigned by the district allocations are not received by April 18, any remaining spaces in the conference will be filled by registrations received up to April 20, 2017.

Conference participants will be reimbursed as per the Federation Guidelines. Accommodation will only be provided to those delegates travelling outside a 100 kilometre range. Conference registrations will be limited to a maximum of 150.

Local leaders are asked to promote this conference as a professional growth opportunity for those members who are reluctant to or minimally use technology in their current educational roles. Registrations for leaders who are not currently in the classroom will not be accepted.
