OCCASIONAL TEACHER REPORT

Here are some issues affecting Occasional Teachers that we would like the Branch Presidents' help with:

1. Make sure Long Term Occasionals (10 days) are paid according to the grid.
2. Long Term Occasionals who teach for an entire semester are entitled to apply for the Board's Benefit package and get the subsidized rate. If they wish to continue the benefits for a period in which they are not working full time, they can still access the benefits but must pay the entire premium cost.
3. Day-to-Day Occasional Teachers should have an identification badge on them issued by office staff.
4. Study Hall Supervisor must not supervise more than three (3) classes, to a maximum of 60 enrolled students.
5. An Occasional Teacher should cover any teacher absences due to OSSTF business/meeting or Board meeting.
6. Short-Term Occasional Teachers who are given a 4th class to cover are not to be given any supervision duties. As well, they can only cover the 4th class on the first day of their assignment.
7. If the price of a field trip includes the cost of supply, please ensure that an Occasional Teacher was called in.
